

Pension Application for Zelek Mead

On this twentieth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty two personally appeared before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas now sitting Zelek Mead a resident of the Town of Harrisburgh in the County of Lewis and State of New York aged eighty one years who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

That he entered the service of the United States and served as herein stated.

In the year seventeen hundred & seventy six he enlisted under Captain Daniel Delavan Lieutenant Samuel Lawrence in the Regiment commanded he thinks by Colonel Thompson of the New York state Troops entered the service in the month of April and served three months marched to Kingsbridge near New York.

In July of the same year he enlisted under the same officers for one year in the New York State troops aforesaid, and immediately entered the service and served till July seventeen hundred & seventy seven when he was discharged. That during this term of service he marched to Kingsbridge where he was discharged. That during this term of service he marched to Kingsbridge remained there some time; from thence he marched to White Plains from then to Morrissena and to Peakskill;. That during this time his regiment had a skirmish with the British they were returning from destroying the America Tories at Danbury, in which he was engaged. That General Arnold had command at Kingsbridge.

That he resided when he entered the service in South Salem Westchester County New York. That he knows of no person whose testimony he can procure who can testify to his service and that he has no documentary evidence. That he entered the service as a volunteer.

That he afterwards served as a volunteer in the New York Militia under captain benedict from the year 1777 to the end of the war, from two to four months in each year.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of the agency of any state. (Signed with his mark) Zelek Mead
