

Pension Application for John Meloy or Maloy

R.7110 (Widow: Susannah)

On this 22nd day of October 1849 personally appeared before me Lyman Tremane County Judge of Greene County, Amos Meloy a resident of Ashland in the county of Green in the State afore said aged seventy years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain he benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 4th 1836 and the act explanatory of said act passed March 3, 1837. That this deponent tis a son of the late John Maloy who was a private in the war of the Revolution and who resided at the time of his performing the service in Columbia County in the State of New York. That the said John Maloy died on the 15 day of July 1793 leaving a widow viz Susanna Maloy this deponent's mother and who died a widow on the 23d day of August 1838 that this deponent said father and mother were married is before the year 1777.

That this deponent was born in 1779 and was the second child o fhsi said fther & mother that the said Susanna Maloy died on the 23d day of August 1838 being his widow at her death and that at her death she left the following named children her surviving being her only children her surviving & that each of them is of the age of twenty one years and upwards to wit John Maloy Tioga Co. N.Y. Amos Meloy of Greene County N.Y. and Daniel Meloy of Orange County N.Y. this declaration and application is made for the purpose of obtaining for th surviving children of the said widow Susanna Maloy the pension due to her at her decease under the act of Congress passed July 4th 1836.
