

Pension Application for Jacobus Miller

W.23990 (Widow: Barbary) Married January 29, 1784, Jacobus died April 1, 1821.
State of New York
Sullivan County SS.

On this 4th day of April 1843 personally appeared before me the undersigned one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas [Pleas] in and for the country of Sullivan in said state, Barbary Miller a resident of Orange County being near and adjacent to Sullivan County aged 79 years who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed March 3d 1843 entitled an Act granting one years Pensions to Widows of persons who served in the War of the Revolution & that she is the Widow of Jacobus Miller who was a soldier and served as such in the War of the Revolution.

She further states that she applied for and received a five years pension at the Rate of about Forty Dollars per annum under the Act of Congress passed July 7th 1838 and that she has not intermarried but continues the widow of the aforesaid Jacobus Miller. (Signed with her mark) Barbary Miller
