

**Pension Application for Jason Miller**

On this 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1832, personally appeared in open court before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Madison now sitting Jason Miller a resident of Brookfield in the County of Madison and State of New York aged sixty nine years who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June the 7<sup>th</sup> 1832.

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers and served as herein stated.

That he lived in the town of Stonington, County of New London and State of Connecticut during the whole time of the Revolution. That he enlisted in Stonington aforesaid in the spring of the year 1779 for the term of six months and served under Captain Ames Hatfield in the regiment commanded by Col. Oliver Smith and Continued in the service the full term of six months and was discharged at Stonington Fort in the fall of the year but the exact time he cannot recollect but continued at Stonington fort the whole time he was in the service at this campaign had no engagement with the enemy and he thinks there was no Continental troops stationed with him at this time, that in the year 1781 he entered the service of the United States by inlisting on or about the first day of March at Stonington aforesaid for the time of one year under Captain Miles in a regiment commanded by Col. Webb he marched to Stonage in the State of Connecticut and then to Stonefield? In the said State and continued there about three months he then marched to White Plains in the State of New York and continued at that place about six months he then returned to Stonage? In the State of Connecticut and continued there until the end of his enlistment and was discharged about the first of March 1782.

That he has no documentary evidence and that he knows of no person whose testimony he can procure who can testify to his service.

He hereby relinquishes every claim to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of the agency of any state.
