Declaration. In order to obtain the Benefit of the Act of Congress passed July 7th 1838 entitled "An act granting half pay and pensions to certain Widows."

On this Fourth day of January one thousand and eight hundred and forty one personally appeared before the Justices Court of the City of Hudson the same being a Court of Record and having a seal Elizabeth Miller a Resident of Claverack in the County aforesaid aged seventy three years who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provisions made by the Act of Congress passed July 7th 1838 entitled "An act granting half pay and Pensions to Certain Widows."

That she is the Widow of Jeremiah C. Muller late of Claverack aforesaid deceased who served in the War of the Revolution as an Ensign in Captain Wendell's Company in Colonel Goose Van Schaacks Regiment in the line of the State of New York. That after his service in the line of the State of New York her said husband the said Jeremiah C. Muller severed in the New York Levies as Lieutenant; for the period of those respective services she refers to the proofs which are hereunto annexed & such other proofs as may be hereunto added—

She further says that she was married to said Jeremiah C. Muller on the seventeenth day of February seventeen hundred and ninety two.

That her said husband Jeremiah C. Muller died on the fifteenth day of October in the year eighteen hundred and ninety two.

That her said husband Jeremiah C. Muller died on the fifteenth day of October in the year eighteen hundred and twenty seven leaving this declarant his widow not having intermarried since his death that she was married to the said Jeremiah C. Muller prior of the first day of January seventeen hundred and ninety four to wit. At the time above stated. All which will more fully appear by reference to the proofs annexed.
