Pension Application for Moses Mingus or Myngos

S.41006 Muskingum County State of Ohio. Sct

Be it known, that before me in the county and state aforesaid personally appeared Moses Mingus and made oath, that he belonged to Col. Malcom's Regiment (In the Revolutionary War) in the year 1777; and served under Capt. James Black; -- that he entered the service of the United States on the 30th day of March 1777, and enlisted during the war, which should continue between Great Britain and America:--

That he entered the service, and continued there in untill the spring of the year 1783, when he was discharged by the regular order of the board of war, signed by Genl Geo. Washington—

That he enlisted and served as a private soldier in the Regiment stated as above, which was raised by Congress – that he has no evidence living to testify to these facts in Ohio, save and excepting himself –that he is now in his 59th year of his age; and that he needs the support of his country in his indigent circumstances. (Signed) Moses Mingus
