I, James Montey of Plattsburgh in the County of Clinton and State of New York do solemnly & sincerely swear & declare that I as a private in the Company commanded by Captain Oliver in Col. Moses Hazen's Regiment called on the Congress Regiments in the Service of the United States of America on the Continental Establishment in the war of the revolution that I enlisted in the Army of the United States at Albany in the Spring that the Army which had been under command of General Montgomery retreated from Canada which I believe was in the spring of the year 1776 in the Regiment of Col. Livingston & was afterwards [afterwards] transferred to the regiment of Col. Hazen & that I served about seven years & upwards and I as discharged at New Windsor in the State of New York in the Spring or Summer after the peace was made with Great Britain, that my discharge was destroyed by one of my children, that I am in very indigent circumstances & am in need of assistance from my country for support & have no property wherewith to support myself.
