Amable Monty of Plattsburgh in the County of Clinton & State of New York do swear & declare that I was a private in the company commanded by Captain Olive in Col. Moses Hazen's Regiment in the service of the United States on the Continental Establishment called the Congress Regiment in the War of the Revolution that I enlisted in the War of the Revolution that I enlisted in the Army of the United States of Albany the spring that the army which had been under the command of General Montgomery [?] from Canada which I believe was in the spring of 1776 in the Regiment of Col. Livingston & was afterwards transferred to the Regiment of Col. Hazen that I served seven years & upwards & was discharged near New Windsor in the State of New York in the spring or summer after Peace was made with Great Brittain that my discharge was lost the first year after my discharge that in very urgent curcumstances [circumstances] & by reason of my reduced curcumstances in life I am in need of assistance from my Country for my support having no property to support myself.
