John Monty of Chazy in the County of Clinton & State of New York being duly sworn deposeth and saith that in the Spring in the year of our Lord 1780 at the Town of Fishkill in the County of Dutchess in the State of New York did enlist in the Continental Army a private [?] or musician in Capt. Laurence Oliver's company Congress' own Ridgement commanded by Brigadier Genl Moses Hazen for and during the war – and this deponent saith that he continued in said army until the peace, and at a place called New Windsor in said State this deponent was dismissed, received his back clothing and was paid off and this deponent said that by reason of his reduced circumstances in life, is in need of assistance from his country for support and further saith not.
