

**Pension Application for Isaac Moore**

Isaac Moore of the town of Pompey in the County of Onondaga & State of New York of the age of fifty two years & upwards being duly sworn deposeth & saith that late in the fall of the year seventeen hundred & eighty one he enlisted into Capt. Isaac Hubbel's Company of the New York line in the Second Regiment of Artillery or New York Artillery commanded by Col. John Lamb—

The Deponent enlisted to serve during the war, & did serve in the said Company until the end of the war in June seventeen hundred & eighty three faithfully against the common enemy when this deponent was discharged—

That the Deponent then received a printed discharge signed by General Washington—

That the Deponent lost the said Discharge soon after the war & the same is not now in existence.—

The deponent further saith that from his reduced circumstances in life he needs the assistance of his Country for his support – The he has no real or personal property whatever except his wearing apparel & one axe—and further he saith not. (Signed with his mark) Isaac Moore.
