

Pension Application for Thomas More or Moore

W.2657 (Widow: Rachel) Married March 9, 1846 to Rachel Dady, Thomas died May 7, 1853.

Thomas More being duly sworn saith that he is a resident of the County of Oneida and State of New York that he is Fifty six—years old and upwards—that by reason of his reduced circumstances in life he is in need of assistance from his country for support—that he never had any pension allowed him by the laws of the United States. That he served as a soldier in the war of the Revolution on the Continental establishment one year and upwards—he entered the service in 1782 in Greggs Company, VanSchaicks Regt, New York line and served therein till the close of the war in 1783 when he was regularly discharged. Discharge lost. (Signed with his mark) Thomas More
