

Pension Application for Joseph Morrell

On this 10th day of February 1822 personally appeared in open court of Common Pleas and a Court of Record of said County of Orange Joseph Morrell aged 66 years resident in said County, who being fully sworn according to law—doth on his oath declare that he served in the Revolutionary War as follows—

That he enlisted in the year 1775—in a Company Commanded by Capt Samuel Raymond and Stationed on the North River—Chiefly employ'd in Building Fortifications – in the Spring of 1776 he enlisted for one year in Colo James Clinton Reg't, Capt. Wm. Jackson's Company, but in the month of December of the same year, he enlisted for During the war in the 4th Regt Colo H. B. Livingston for during the war—in the 4th NY Regt Colo. H. B. Livingston in Capt. Israel Smith's Company, that he continued to serve until the year 1780 when the Regt was reduced and he was arranged in the first N. Y. Regt Colo Goose VanSchaick in Capt. Capt. [sic] [?] Austin's Company where he continued until the peace 1783 when the army was disbanded and I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift or in any other manor [manner] disposed of my property or any part thereof, with intent I hereby so to Diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of the Act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Navel [naval] Service in the Revolutionary War—passed the 18th day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time nor has any person interest for me my property or securities or debt due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereunto annexed and by me subscribed No. Ct. 1476 Apl. 1st 1818.
