I certify that, in conformity with the Law of the United States, of the 18<sup>th</sup> of March, 1818,

Daniel Morris late a private in the Army of the Revolution, is inscribed on the Pension List, Roll of the New York Agency, at the rate of Eight dollars per month, to commence on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.

Given at the War Office of the United States, this Twenty first day of November one thousand eight hundred and eighteen. J.C. Calhoun , Secretary of War.
