

Pension Application for David Mosher

On this eleventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two personally appeared before me Albro Akin one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas [Pleas] for said County, David Mosher a resident of the Town of Dover, in the County of Dutchess and State of New York aged eighty four years, who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June the 7th 1832—

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers and served as hereafter stated viz.

That he enlisted under Capt. William Clark in a company of Rangers, in this County and their duty was to patrol the County and protect the inhabitants from the depredations of the enemy was frequently stationed near Peekskill in the County of Westchester never served with the regular army, served in that company four months and received fifty three and four [?] per month in continental money for his services, never had no discharge, after which he served in the militia in Capt. Jonathan Dennison's Company, was frequently called out in alarms during the war, from two to four weeks at a time cannot tell exactly the time he served in the militia but thinks at least two years. The following interrogatories were then put to the applicant.

Q. Where and in what year was you born.

A. Was born in the Town of Union Vale in this county does not know the year.

Q. Have you any record of your age and if so where is it.

A. I have had a record of my age, but it is lost.

Q. Where were you living when called into service.

A. In the county of Dutchess and State of N. York.

Q. Did you ever receive a discharge.

A. no. State the names of some persons in your neighbourhood for veracity and their belief of your service I would refer to Benjamin Albro, Benjamin Love, & others.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of the agency of any state. Sworn to and subscribed the day and year aforesaid before me. Albro Akin.
