

**Pension Application for Basil or Basile Nadeau or Baszill Nedeau**

On this seventy ninth day of May 1819, before me the subscriber, one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas of the county and state aforesaid: Personally appears Basil Nadeau aged sixty seven years, resident in Champlain in the said county and state, who being by me first duly sworn, according to law, doth, on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress, entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the revolutionary war:"

That the said Basile Nadeau enlisted in Albany in the state of New York in the company commanded by Captain Oliver in the Regiment of Col. Hazen in July or August 1776 that he continued to serve in the said corps; when he was discharged from service in New Windsor state of New York; that he was in the battles of Staten Island, Germantown, Brandywine, [Wawarsing?] & YorkTown, and that he is in reduced circumstances, and stands in need of the assistance of his country for support; and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services. His discharge is lost. (Signed with his mark) Basile Nadeau
