

Pension Application for Stephen Niles

Letter in folder dated September 9, 1932, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter dated August 10, 1922, you are advised that from the records of this Bureau, it appears that Ichabod Niles of Alburgh, Grand Isle County, Vermont, and Paul Niles of Westville, Franklin County, New York, applied on February 22, 1853 for pension as the only surviving children of Stephen Niles, late of Alburgh, New York, who served as a Captain in Colonel VanRensselaer's New York Regiment, during the war of the Revolution, and was discharged in Albany in 1783.

Their application was informal and the claim was not completed.

There is no further information on file as to service or family.

The Revolutionary War records of this Bureau fail to afford any information in regard to Lieutenant Jonathan Niles.
