

### **Bounty Land for Jacob Odle**

B.L.Register 234532-55 (no pension claim)

Widow: Margaret

State of New York

County of Washington

On this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December AD 1855 personally appeared before me a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid Margaret Odle aged ninety (90) years a Resident of the Town of Queensbury in the State of New York who being duly sworn according to Law declares that she is the widow of Jacob Odle late of said Town of Queensbury deceased who was a private in a company of New York militia commanded by Captain Augustin Odle (Father of the said Jacob Odle) in a Regiment Commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Henry K. V. Rensselaer in the war with Great Britain known as the Revolutionary War.

Her said husband was called out and mustered into service in said Revolutionary War on different alarms and excursions for the term of fourteen days and over as will appear by the certificate of the Comptroller fvo the State of New York hereunto annexed.

She further states that she was married to the said Jacob Odle in Shaftsbury in the State of Vermont onteh 27<sup>th</sup> day of march 1784 by one [blank] Olden a Judge of one of the Courts of the State of Vermont and that her name before her marriage was Margaret Butler. That her said husband died at Queensbury aforesaid on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April AD 1831 and that she is now a widow.

That neither she or her said husband ever received bounty land for this or any other service from the United States or before this made any application therefor.

She makes this declaration for the purpose of obtaining the Bounty Land to which she may be entitled under the act approved March 3d 1855. And she hereby appoints Benjamin H. Baldwin Esqr of Washington City D.C. her attorney to prosecute her claim and receive her warrant when issued. (Signed with; her mark) Margaret Odle.
