To Jabez Clarke Esqr, Judge of the Court of Common Pleas within and for the County of Windsor, and State of Connecticut. The petitioner of William Paul of the Town of Woodstock in said County Sheweth, that in the month of March AD 1777, Inlisted in Capt'n John Lees company in Col'o Lewis Dubois's regiment in the New York State Levies in the service of the United States for and during the then revolutionary war—and served in s'd regiment, until the peace and was discharged in June or July 1783 but has no discharge in existence, that he is poor & in reduced circumstances & needs the assistance of his country for support, and prays that the benefit of an act of Congress of the 18th day of March 1818. Dated at Woodstock the 16th day of April 1818. (Signed with his mark) William Paul
