

**Pension Application for Henry Peran or Peron**

On this 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1820, personally appeared before the Judges of the court of Common Pleas for the County of Bergen in open Court being a Court of record, possessing a seal having a Jurisdiction unlimited in point of amount & proceeding according to the course of the common Law, Henry Peron aged seventy years resident of the County aforesaid, who being first duly sworn according to law doth on his oath declare that he served as a soldier in the revolutionary war five years and one month in Captain Satterly's compy, Genl Hazens Regiment that the date of his original application was on the 7<sup>th</sup> April 1818.

That he has rec'd a certificate from the War Department as a Pensioner inscribed on the Pension List or Roll of the New Jersey Agency dated 27<sup>th</sup> July 1818; being number 1969.

And I do solemnly swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1818; and that I have not since that time by gift, sale, or in any manner disposed of my property, or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provision of an Act of Congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons engaged in the land & naval service of the United States in the revolutionary War", passed the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1818, and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities, contracts or debts due to me, nor have I any income other than what is contained in the schedule hereto annexed & by me subscribed, that my occupation is that of a common labourer that from my age & Infirmities I am unable to labour but very little –scarcely as much as one day in a week, that with the common infirmities attendant on old age, he is often attacked with the rheumatism so that he is prevented from any labour.
