

Disability for Johannes Petri

Disability

Letters in this folder contain all the information available. The following is dated October 3, 1939.

In a report of the Secretary of war printed in 1835 in relation to the pension establishment of the United States is found the name of Johannes Petri. This soldier received an annual allowance of \$12 for disability incurred during his service as private in the Revolutionary War. He is listed among the invalid pensioners inscribed on the roll of New York Agency whose residence and other information cannot be ascertained in consequence of the destruction of the papers by a fire in the War Office in November, 1800.

Because of the destruction of papers in the claim, this office is unable to furnish any further data relative to Johannes Petri and no data whatever in regard to his family.

This is the only Johannes Petri (name does not appear as Johan Jost Petrie) that is found in the Revolutionary War records of this office.
