

Pension Application for Jotham Prindle

I Jotham Prindle of the town of Cheshire in said County, a resident citizen of the United States do declare on oath that I served my country as a soldier during the whole of the Revolutionary War.

I first served as a green Mountain Boy In the Regiment of Col. Warner and afterwards in the year 1777 I enlisted into Capt Fink's company in the Regiment commanded by Col VanSchaick in the New York Line, Continental Establishment & served I the same company under the successive commands of Captains Fink, Wendall and TenBroek, until the close of the war, when I was honourably discharged; but my discharge being lost, by time & accident, cannot now be produced—

I further declare on oath that I now need the assistance of my country for support, by reason of my reduced circumstances in life. I therefore pray that I may be enrolled on the pension List of the United States according to the provisions of the act of Congress entitled "An act to provide for certain persons in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War." (Signed) Jotham Prindle
