

Pension Application for Abram Quick

W.15941 (Widow: Jane) Married Jane Devoe. Abram died 1819. This file doesn't contain a lot of details of Abram's service.

Rensselaer County SS.

On this 29th day of October 1849 personally appeared before me Ebenezer C. Barton a Justice of the Peace of the county aforesaid. The under named deponent aged 98 years a resident of the aforesaid county, who being duly sworn according to law testifies that he was well acquainted with Abram Quick and I am his wife, whose maiden name was Devoe.

That they all then resided in Albany now Saratoga County. That before Burgoyne's Surrender said Abram enlisted or [?] said in the neighborhood in the service for 3 years in and of the York Regt before his time expired this deponent saw said Abram in the service in Col. Dubois Regt this he well remembers by knowing one other person in the same Regt by the name of Adam Hartman. And further that said Abram and I was said to have been married some time before he enlisted. Lived together acknowledged themselves as [?] and so ;reputed in the neighborhood to the time of his death. This deponent is also acquainted with Mariah their daughter applying for a pension for her father's service under the act of 1836. (Signed with his mark) Abram Wilson
