

Pension Application for James Quick

For the purpose of obtaining the benefit of an act entitled "A act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldiers of the army of the revolution" approved on the 15th of May 1828, I James Quick of Asylum in the County of Bradford in the State of Pennsylvania do hereby declare that I enlisted in the Continental Line of the Army of the revolution for and during the war and continued in its service until its termination at which period I was a private in Captain Jacob DeWitt's Company in the New York Line.

And I also declare that I afterwards received a certificate for the reward of eighty dollars to which I was enrolled as I believe, under a resolve of Congress passed the 15th of May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the 15th day of March 1828 on the pension list of the United States. (Signed with his mark) James Quick
