

Pension Application for Thomas Reid or Read

W.4317 (Widows; Catharine)

B.L.Wt.1807-400-Surgeon. Issued Dec. 15, 1791. Married July 28, 1777, and Thomas died September 18, 1826. This pension paid \$600 a year.

On this 11th day of October one thousand eight hundred and thirty six personally appeared before the undersigned a Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of said County (being a court of record) Catharine Reid a resident of the town of Ephratah in the County of Montgomery and State of New York aged seventy five years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth on her oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the Act of Congress passed July 4th 1836.

That she is the widow of Thomas Reid who was a surgeon in the New York Continental line of the revolutionary Army in Col. James Livingston's Regiment and whose services will fully appear reference being had to the records of the war department at war office of the United States.

She further declares that she was married to the said Thomas Reid on the twenty eighth day of July one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven that her husband the aforesaid Thomas Reid died on the 18th day of September 1826, and that she has remained a widow ever since that period as will more fully appear by reference to the proof hereunto annexed.
