

**Pension Application for Daniel Roe**

Daniel Roe of the Town of Brookhaven in the County of Suffolk and State of New York aged about seventy eight years being duly sworn doth depose and say that he received a Captain Commission about the first of March in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six and enlisted a full company of Infantry in the United States Establishment and served in the fourth Regiment commanded by Coll Henry B. Livingston's in the New York line in the regular army of the United States, that he continued to serve in that crops untill about the first day of march one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven he and his company was regularly discharged from the service at Fort Montgomery in the County of Orange in the State of New York that he was engaged in a battle at Brookhaven in the State of New York on Long Island that we billeted wounded and destroyed the detachment, and this deponent further sayeth that he is in reduced circumstances and stands in need of his country for support, that at the time he left the service he obtained a regular discharge.

The said commission he now has which he now produces, that he has no other evidence in his power [in] relation to his services, and this deponent heretofore allowed him by the laws of the United States, except the pension which he may be entitled to under the late act of Congress entitled an act to provide for certain persons engaged In the land and Naval service in the Revolutionary War. Letter in folder dated June 16, 1926, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you from the papers in the Revolutionary War pension claim, S.47973, it appears that Daniel Roe was commissioned March 1, 1776, as Captain in the Second Battalion of New York Troops, was in and engagement at brook Haven on Long Island and was discharged March 1, 1777.

He was allowed pension on his application executed June 6, 1818, while ar resident of Brook Haven, Suffolk County, New York, aged seventy-eight years.

There is no data on file relative to his family.

There is no affidavit by Daniel in this folder.
