

Pension Application for Daniel G. Rogers

R.3970 (Elizabeth Galley, former widow) Married January 1, 1784. Daniel died July fifth 1811. Elizabeth married John Galley August 7, 1812, and John died March 15, 1826.

Be it known that personally appeared before me Charles Borland Surrogate of the county of Orange and State aforesaid Elizabeth Galley a resident of said County aged 79 years who being first duly sworn before me in open court being a court of Record help in and for said county, land doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress passed July 7th 1838.

That she is the widow of John Galley – now deceased late of said County and that she was formerly the widow of Daniel G. Rogers decd late of said County, and that the aforesaid Daniel G. Rogers and others and believes the same to be true—

That in the year of 1776 he entered the service on about the first of ;May of that year and served about one year she thinks in Colonel Dubois' regiment of Rangers and served in Dutches [Dutchess] & WestChester Counties, his captain's name she cannot state.

And that about the first of July of 1780 he entered the service and served under Captain Joshua Drake and served in the countys of Westchester and Dutches on the Hudson river. She thinks he served untill some time in the month of November of that year. And also that her husband the aforesaid Daniel G. Rogers served under Captain Dunning a short time in the month of November or December of 1780.

And that in the year of 1781 he entered the service and served under Captain Abraham Westfall in Colonel Paulding's regiment and served six or eight months on the western frontier in the county of Ulster to guard the inhabitants against the Indians.

And she further states that she was married to her husband the aforesaid Daniel G. Rogers on the first day of January 1784, by the Rev. Mr. Kerr who was then Pastor of the Presbeterion [Presbyterian] Church at Goshen in said County and that her husband the aforesaid Daniel G. Rogers died on the fifth day of July 1811 In said county and that she was married to John Galley on the seventh day of August 1812 and that he the aforesaid John Galley died on the 15th day of March 1826, and that she has remained a widow since his death.

And she further states that she was not married to the aforesaid Daniel G. Rogers her first husband prior to his leaving the service but the marriage took place previous to the first of January seventeen hundred and ninety four; viz at the time above stated. (Signed) Elizabeth Galley
