Your are further advised that the list of Invalid Pensioners for Dutchess County, New York, reported by the Secretary of War, shows that one Silvanus Seely, a Private in Graham's New York regiment, was pensioned at \$48. Per annum from November 16, 1784 and at \$76.80 per annum from April 14, 1816.

There is no further information concerning him as there are no papers on file in this bureau, the same having been destroyed when the War Office was burned.
