

### Pension Application for Jabez Sherman

County of Warren SS.

On this 7<sup>th</sup> day of September 1833 personally appeared before me Hobby Mead one of the Judges of the Court of Common Please [sic] and General Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Warren aforesaid and State of New York Jabez Sherman a resident of Chester in the County of Warren and State of New York aged 78 years who being first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the Benefit of the Provisions made by the Act of Congress passed June the 7<sup>th</sup> 1838. That he entered in the service of the United States under the following named officers and served as herein stated. Theophilus Cotton was the Collonel and Aell Clapp was Captain and Isaac Pope was Lieutenant. He volunteered on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of April in 1775 and served 8 month[s] in that company and was discharged on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1776 and the winter of 1778 he volunteered in the Malilia [Militia] for three months and marched to Rhode Island under Lieutenant Doty to keep gard or to gard [guard] the Narragansett Shore the west side of Rhode Island. He resided in the town of Rochester in the County of Plymouth in the State of Massachusetts and marched to Boston the 1<sup>st</sup> enlistment in 1775 and served in Boston Neck and was there when the British marched out of the city to the Battle of Bunker Hill, and his time was out the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1776 and was volunteer in the service. Marched from Rochester to Boston with the 2d service was in the service in 1778 in the winter and served three months and has no documentary evidence, and that he knows of no person whose testimony he can procure who can testify to his service.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of any agency of any state. (Signed) Jabez Sherman.
