

Pension Application for Christopher Shoefelt, Shufeldt, Zufeld

W.19024 (Widow: Christina. Christopher Shufeldt and Christian Simon were married May 30, 1793 in the First Evangelical Lutheran Church, Rhinebeck, Dutchess Co., N.Y. by Charles Schaeffer, Pastor. Christopher died April 5, 1833.)

Stephen C. Getter of the Town Masonville County and State aforesaid being duly sworn deposes and says that he was personally acquainted with Christopher Shoefelt, the Husband of Christina Shoefelt and knows that he enlisted as a private in the Malitia of this state at Albany in May 1782 and that he served in the Revolutionary War as such private from the term of his enlistment till the close of the war, and further says that the said Christopher Shoefelt served as a private in the Revolutionary War previous to the time of his enlistment as aforesaid but for what length of time is not known by this deponent, and this deponent further says that he was acquainted with him from that time till the time of his death, and that he died in the Town and County of Schoharria [Schoharie?] in the said State of New York at the age of 86 years and died April 5, 1833, and that he never drew a pension, and further says that the said Christina Shoefelt was the wife of the said Christopher Shoefelt and that she has not been married since his death but still remains his widow and that she has never drawn a pension.
