Declaration, In order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress of the 7th June, 1832.

State of New York

County of Ulster SS.

On this eleventh day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred & thirty two personally appeared in open court, before the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas, of the County of Ulster aforesaid, now sitting Daniel Sluyter a resident of the town of New Paltz in said County, aged sixty eight years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth, on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the Act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named officers, and served as herein stated.

That in the year 1782 he entered in the service as a Volunteer in Rhinebeck, Dutchess County for the period of Nine Months, in a company of which Lieutenant Dubois acted as Captain in Colonel Weisenvelt's Regiment. That he served out his period of enlistment on the then frontiers in Ulster County in the Town of Hurley, Marletown, and Saugerties, that he was born in the year 1764 in the Town of New Paltz in the County of Ulster. That the record of his age is in the Parish Register of the Reformed Dutch Church of New Paltz aforesaid. That when he entered the service he resided in said Town of New Paltz where he has resided since the Revolutionary War. He cannot state the names of the officers with more precision than as above mentioned that he never received a written or printed discharge. That he refers to the Annexed Certificate of the Reverend James E. Quan and William Deyo who reside in his immediate neighborhood to testify as to his character for veracity and their belief of his service as above stated.

He hereby relinquishes ever claim whatever, to a pension or annuity, except the present, and declares that his name is not on the Pension Roll of any Agency in any State. (Signed) Daniel Sluyter.
