Sir,

In answer to your communication of the 25th ultimo, relative to an application for pension supposed to have been forwarded in 1851-2, on account of the service of Oliver Stacey in the war of the Revolution, you are advised that no such papers are on file in this bureau.

The soldier applied for pension in 1821-2 but there was not then, nor was there before his decease in 1822, nor before that of his widow in 1825, any law existing, under which enter would have been entitled to pension, and it is probably for this reason the agent for who prepared the papers, did not file them in 1851-2.
