

Bounty Land Information for Levi Stockwell, Lieutenant

I advise you that from the records of this bureau it appears that on March 31, 1796, a warrant for two hundred acres of bounty land was issued on account of the services of Levi Stockwell, Lieutenant of the New York Line, War of the Revolution.

There are no further data relative to his services and none whatever relative to his family, due to the destruction of papers in such claims when the War Office was burned in November 1800.
