Washington Jan'y 27, 1838.

Sir, One of my constituents, Mr. Teunis Swart, about a year ago forwarded his papers on Mr. Seymour, my predecessor for the purpose of procuring a pension I suppose no papers were sent by Mr. Seymour to our office, will you do me the favor to inform me how the matter stands.

Dr. Sir, [To J. S. Edwards, Esq.] I have never examined the papers in the case of Mr. Teunis Swart of Delaware County N. Y. who applies for a pension but I am informed 10 ½ months since were clearly proved & that there was presumptive evidence for three months more—if you find on re-examining the papers that you cannot allow him for any portion of the time will you do ;me the favor of the time will you do me the favor to find me all the original papers or copies of them that I may submit them to Congress.
