Know all men by their Presents that I John Tubbs of the Town of Elmira in the County of Tioga and State of New York do by these presents make Ordain authorize Constitute and appoint my trusty friend Waterman Baldwin of Town and County aforesaid my true and lawful, Attorney for me and in my name Place and Stead to ask for Demand Revise and Recover from the Propper Office of the United States all such monies Land and Estate or Property which is due to me as a Son and only heir to John Tubbs Slain, when being a Soldier belonging to the Army of the United States of America during the Revolutionary war with Great Britain and further to use all lawful means to Receive, the same as Shall be Just and Reasonable and to the same to his own use and Benefit, wit full and Complete power to sell and Convey the same or do any thing in the Premise he shall think proper, hereby Ratifying and Confirming all and Singular whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do in premises, In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 13th day of September in the year of our Lord 1808.
