On this 30<sup>th</sup> day of Au'gst 1838 personally appeared before the undersigned one of the Judge of Court of Common Pleas in and for the said County Rosanah Upright a resident of Shawangunk in said County and State Aged 78 years in December next who being duly sworn according to law doth on her oath make the following Declaration in order to obtain the Benefits of the provision of the act of Congress passed July 7 1838, entitled an act granting half pay to Certain Widows.

That she is the widow of Michael Upright who was a private soldier in the army of the Revolution that she has been informed and believes her said husband served in Captain Smith Company Col. VanCortland Regtment [Regiment] through out the war.

She further declares that she was married to her said husband the said Michael Upright on the 27<sup>th</sup> day Feb'r 1785 by the Reverend VanNess that her said husband died on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1806.

That she has remained a widow ever since that her name before marriage was Rosanah Suter that the said marriage did not take place prior to his leaving the service but the marriage took place previous to first of January viz at the time above stated. (Signed with her mark) Rosanah Upright.
