

**Pension Application for Nanning Vanderheyden**

W.19570 (Widow: Catharine) Catherine Levisse married Nanning VanDerhyden on November 13, 1780. Nanning died August 22, 1791.

On this nineteenth day of January in the year Eighteen Hundred and forty one Personally appeared before the Justices of the Justices Court of the City of Troy now sitting Anna Lansing of the town of Lansingburgh County and State aforesaid aged fifty eight years, who being duly sworn according to law. Doth on her oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the provision made by the act of Congress Passed July 4<sup>th</sup> 1836.

That she is the only child and lawful Heir of Nanning Vanderhyden and Catherine Vanderheyden deceased and that the said Naning died in the town of Half Moon County of Saratoga State aforesaid on the twenty second day of August Seventeen Hundred and Ninety one, under whom she claims to be allowed for the services of her farther [father] in the War of the Revolution as Lieutenant in the State troops and Militia of the State of New York as will appear from the certificate commission Letters &c, hereunto annexed. And that I the said Anna this deponent ask to be allowed what would have been due my mother the said Catherine for the Revolutionary Services of her husband the said Nanning and the said Catherine were married in the town of Scaticook [Schaghticoke] in the Rensselaer County aforesaid on the Thirtieth day of Nov'r in the year seventeen hundred and eighty as will appear by the annexed affidavit. and that the said Catherine remained the widow of the said Naning and never intermarried to the time of his death in the town of Lansingburgh Rensselaer County aforesaid on the fourteenth day of June eighteen and Thirty Eight.
