Isaac Van Tyne of the town of Fishkill being duly sworn deposes & says that he is sixty three years of age that he enlisted in the service, of the United States in the beginning of the revolutionary war that he was present as a soldier in the army of the attack on Quebec that he served for three years & was discharged at Albany by Genl James Clinton that he belonged to the company of Captain Henry Dubois in the regiment commanded by Col Lewis Dubois in the N York line on the Continental Establishment, the precise time of his discharge he does not recollect but it was at the expiration of three years from the time of his first enlistment that he has lost his said discharge that he is in such reduced circumstances as to require the assistance of his Country for support & that he has never received any pension.
