

Bounty Land for Henry Van Woert

Issued Aug 25, 1790.

Letter in file dated May 15, 1926, written in response to an inquiry.

In response to your letter of the twelfth instant, I have to advise you that this Bureau is unable to furnish the history of a soldier of the Revolution, unless a claim for pension or bounty land has been made on account of his services; and you are herewith furnished the histories of the only Henry and Isaac Van Woert (all spellings of that name searched), who served as officers in the New York Troops , found on the records of this Bureau.

From the records of this Bureau, it appears that Warrant No. 2252 for 200 acres of bounty land was issued August 25, 1790, on account of the services of Lieutenant Henry Van Woert of the New York Line, War of the Revolution.

There is no further information on file as to his services, nor any data on file.
