John Venus to me well known as a Pensioner of the United States on the list of the New York Agency, appeared before me and made oath that he was placed on the Pension list by an act of Congress. That he was wounded by a Musket Ball at the Capture of Burgoyne in the Revolutionary War that he served in Capt. Hallett's Company in the Regiment comm'd by Col. Courtlandt. And this deponent further made oath that he never received an original Pension Certificate under the hand and Seal of the Secretary of War. (Signed with his mark) John Venus
