

Pension Application for William Vradenbergh

On this 16th day of November 1818 before me the Subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the county of Cayuga in said State personally appears William Vradenbergh aged 62 years resident in the Town of Palen in the County of Seneca and State aforesaid who being by me first duly sworn according to law, doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress.

That the said William Vradenbergh enlisted in the Town of Johnstown in the state of ;New York in the company command[ed] by Captain Leonard Bleeker under Col. Van Schaick in the 1st New York Regiment about the year 1776 in the month of April for an during the war & that he served out his time & was honourably discharged at New-bergh in the State of New York on the 8th day of June 1783 and that he was in the Siege of Fortstanwicks [Fort Stanwix] & on the Western Expedition [Expedition] under Sullivan & in the Battle of YorkTown & that he is reduced circumstances and stands in need of assistance from his County fro support.
