

## **Pension Application for Orra Vredenburg**

Seneca County SS.

On this sixth day of October A.D. 1832 personally appeared in open Court, before the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Seneca and State of New York now setting, Orra Vredenburg a resident of Tyre in the County of Seneca and State of New York aged 77 or 78 years, who being first duly sworn, according to law, doth on his oath, make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress, passed June 7<sup>th</sup> 1832:--

That he entered the service under the following named officers, and served as herein stated:--

That in the winter or spring of the year 1775 at the town of Kinderhook in the State of New York he enlisted into the company of New York State troops commanded by Capt David Van Ness & first Lieut Peter Vosburgh, John Van Ness Second Lieutenant, in Col Van Brinks Regiment as he believes that said company was raised for the purpose of marching against Canada with Gen. Montgomery, that he marched with said company to Albany where he was stationed for a term of four months, and marched from thence north to Bemis Heights where he remained about four or five months from thence back to Albany and from thence to ;Kinderhook aforesaid where he was discharged. That he continued in said service for a term of ten months.

He further declares that afterwards in the fall of the year 1778 as he believes at Kinderhook aforesaid he again entered said service as a substitute (but for whom he does not remember) in the company commanded by Captain Jacob Vosburgh. That he Marched with said company about twenty miles below Poughkeepsie when he was stationed and continued to serve a term of two months when he was discharged.

That he never received a written discharge from said service as he believes.

That he has no proof of said services and is not able to procure any that he does not recollect the name of any continental officer.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pension or annuity except the present, and declares that his name is not on the pension roll of any State or Territory.
