

### **Bounty Land for Benjamin Walker**

Letter in folder dated October 20, 1934, written in response to an inquiry.

Reference is made to your letter relative to Benjamin Walker, Lieutenant Colonel, the Revolutionary War.

The records of this office show that Warrant No. 2364 for four hundred fifty acres of bounty land was issued August 4, 1790, on account of the services of Benjamin Walker, Lieutenant Colonel of the New York Line, War of the Revolution.

There are no further information on file as to hi services, nor any data as to his family because of the destruction of papers in such claims, when the War Office was burned in November 1800.

This is the record of the only Lieutenant Colonel Benjamin Walker that is found on the Revolutionary War records of this office.
