John Walsh of the Town of Osasco & County aforesaid being duly sworn deposeth & saith that in the spring of the year 1776 he enlisted for six months into the service of the United States under Cap. John Oeden in the first Regiment of the New York troops commanded by Colonel Van Schaick & served out the same & then enlisted for during the war under Cap. John in the same Regiment above mentioned & that he served during the war & was honorable [honorably] discharged after the peace at Newburg in the state of New York from the same Regiment, but that his discharge is now lost.

And he further saith that by reason of reduced circumstances he is in need of assistance from his Country for support.
