

Pension Application for Henry Wandell

On this twenty seventh day of August 1832 personally appeared in open court, before the Judges of the County Court now sitting Henry Wandell a resident of the town of Canadice, County and State aforesaid aged seventy years who being first sworn according to Law, doth on his Oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the benefit of the act of Congress passed June 7, 1832.

That he entered the service of the United States under the following named Officers and served as herein stated.

1st At Warwick County of Orange and State of New York on the 1st May 1779 was marched in Captain Faulkner's Company in Colonel Spaulding's or Pawling's Regiment to the Frontier to guard against the Indians and was on the Susquehanna and was ordered back and was marched to Fishkill to Peekskill and Stoney Point and was discharged at the latter part of November, and was on duty about 7 months.

2^d He enlisted on the 13th March 1780 in Captain Brodericks Company in Colonel Spencers Regiment at Warwick as aforesaid and was first marched to Mendon Hutts, in Morristown New Jersey, which was Head Quarters, saw General Washington there and was in guard for three weeks at his house. General Maxwell Commanded his Brigade. He was in Bergen County part of the time under Captain Bunnell where General LaFeayette was in command, this was in Colonel Ogden's Regiment after this was returned back to Colonel Spencer's regiment and remained there until discharged at Stoney Point the 31st December and then returned home to Warwick, having served ten months & a half in this Campaign. Has no documentary evidence, knows Benjamin Garlinghouse of Naples and Artemas Briggs of Richmond, was born in New Burgh the 29th August 1762. Has lived in his present place of residence for more than twenty years past and previous thereto he lived in Scipio in Cayuga County. Has no record of his age.

He hereby relinquishes every claim whatever to a a [sic] Pension or annuity except [except] the present and declares his name is not on the Pension Roll of the Agency of any State. (Signed with his Mark) Henry Wandell
