

Pension Application for Nathan Warden

On this Twentieth day of April 1818 before me the subscriber one of the Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for said County personally appears Nathan Warden aged 67 years resident in the said County who being by me first duly sworn according to Law doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provision made by the late act of Congress entitled "an act to provide for certain persons engaged in the Land and Naval Service of the United States in the Revolutionary War."

That the said Nathan Warden enlisted as a private soldier in the Army of the United States in the month of May 1777 for a term of three years in the New York Line, Colonel Gansvoort's Regiment, Capt Aaron Parsons company and that he faithfully served the term for which he enlisted and was discharged at Albany in the year 1780 and that he had served at various other periods in the Army during the Revolutionary War and that from his reduced circumstances he stands in need of the assistance of his Country for support and that he has no other evidence now in his power of his said services.
