His name appears on a list of applicants for invalid pension returned by the District Court for the District of New York, submitted to the House of Representatives by the Secretary of War on Feb 21, 1795 and printed in the American State Papers, Class 9, page 157.

Rank: Corporal

Colonel Harrison's 1st regiment of artillery

Disability: wounded in his leg by a bayonet

When and where disabled; July 16, 1779, Stony Point.

Residence; Mamakating

Remarks; Enlisted July 6, 1777.

Evidence complete respecting that the examining physicians do not precisely state the degree of his disability.
