Sir

The papers of George N. Weaver have again been examined. The applicant alleges in his supplemental declaration that he enlisted as a minute man for and during the war in Col. Bellinger's Regiment in the month of March or 1<sup>st</sup> of April 1775. It does not appear from any evidence in the Department that Col. Bellingers Regiment was then in service.

Every applicant is required by the regulations to produce the best evidence in his power. There are numerous claimants in the County of Herkimer who served under Col. Bellinger & in Capt. Hunters Company. The affidavit of some one of them at least should be obtained in order to ascertain this claim. The case is suspended and the papers placed on file. I am—
