

Pension Application for John Webb

For the purpose of obtaining the benefits of the act entitled "An act for the relief of certain surviving officers & soldiers of the Army of the Revolution" approved on the 15 of May 1828. I John Webb of the City & County of new York in the State of New York, do hereby declare, that I enlisted in the Continental line of the army of the Revolution for and during the War and continued in its service until its termination at which period I was a corporal in Captain Hallett's company in the Second Regiment of the New York Line.

And I also declare that I afterwards received certificates for the reward of eighty dollars; to which I was entitled under a resolve of Congress passed the [??]15th of May 1778.

And I further declare that I was not on the fifteenth day of May 1828 in the pension list of the United States. Witness my hand this seventh day of September in the year eighteen hundred & twenty eight. (Signed) John Webb
