

Pension Application for John Winchell

R.11696 (Widow: Mary) Despite the statement that John filed a claim in 1832 before he died, there is no deposition in his file by him.

Very poor condition of family record.

John Winchell and Mary Dunlap was Married [Married} May the 7 1787 on Tuesday.

James Winchell Born January the 15 1788 on Sunday

Catherine Winchell Born September the 5 1790 on Sunday.

Juddy Winchell Born April the 21 1793.

Departed this life August the 30 1794 aged 16 months and 10 days.

John Welch Winchell Born February the 13 1795

Moyer Winchell Born November the 8 1798 morning

Jolatty Winchell Born January the 22, 1801

? Winchell Born March the 19 1803 on Satterday. [Saturday] at one in the morning.

Henry Winchell Born October the 16 804 on Tuesday at ten oclock

Gillisie Winchell Born on Fryday June the 24 1808 at ten o'clock in the evening.

Moyer Burtis Winchell born on SatterDay November the 29 1823 at 8 in the Evening

John Winchell Departed this life in the 68 year of his age Oct 13, 1832.

Letter in folder dated August 20, 1849.

The papers in the case of Mary Winchell dec'd widow of John Winchell have been examined and file.

The evidence as to the marriage is satisfactory, but the proof now furnished does not identify her husband with the soldier, credited with service under Colonels Harper and Schuyler, with the requisite certainty, particularly that under Schuyler as the first name is not given, whether his name was John, or any other name. The balance of the service is admitted would not be sufficient to bring her claim within the provisions of the Acts of congress granting pensions to widows.

John Winchell presented a claim under the Act of June 7, 1832. He papers were returned to his agent Jacob Lancing, with a brief containing the objections to the allowance of his application. These papers should be again sent to this office fi they can be obtained. They may possibly furnish the proof required.
