Letter in folder dated June 17, 1925, written in response to an inquiry.

I have to advise you;, that from the records of this Bureau it appears that Warrant No. 2558 for two-hundred acres of bounty land was issued June 2, 1790, on account of the Revolutionary War services of Lieutenant Jothan Wright of the New York Artillery Artificers.

There are no further data on file as to his services and no data at all as to his family, owing to the destruction of papers in such claims, when the War Office was burned in November 1800.
